Terms & Conditions

- You can apply for up to £100 towards registration fees for an online meeting.
- The decision of the Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer is final and applications will not be reconsidered once a decision has been made.
- To be eligible for a Bursary you must have been a member of the RMS for a minimum of one year at the time of application. This can be verified by the RMS Office. You must also have been accepted to present an abstract at the conference for which you are applying for funding.
- If a candidate is successful in their application, they must submit a meeting report to the RMS. The decision of whether to publish it in *infocus* magazine is at the discretion of the RMS.
- If a successful candidate is unable to attend the conference for which they were awarded a bursary, they must inform the RMS as soon as practicable and refund the money in full within 30 days of the cancellation date.
- Only in exceptional circumstances will the Society fund more than one bursary per member/Fellow in any financial year (January to December).
