

## elmi2021 Abstract Submission Terms and Conditions

By submitting an abstract you have agreed to the terms and conditions as set out below.

1. By submitting an abstract you agree to give us permission on behalf of all presenters if it is accepted for presentation, to publish, reproduce, distribute, display and store the abstract (submitted text only), together with author names, and biographies where supplied, worldwide in all forms (including on the elmi website), formats and media now known or as developed in the future, including print, electronic and digital forms.
2. The author is responsible for the accuracy of the abstract and should ensure that they have written entirely original work which does not infringe any copyright.
3. The corresponding author should ensure that all appropriate co-authors are included on the abstract and that the submission has been approved by all authors.
4. At least one author must present the abstract if selected for the programme for either an oral or poster presentation. Full instructions will be provided by the event organiser.
5. All authors presenting at the conference must register and pay to attend the conference as a delegate. If the presenting author is not registered as a conference delegate, the abstract will be withdrawn. The authors will immediately notify the RMS if they are unable to present an abstract or if the presenting author is changed.
6. If the author(s) have any commercial interest or associations that might pose a conflict of interest regarding their submission, they must be declared. If accepted for presentation, the commercial interest or association must be declared on the title slide (for oral presentations) or at the bottom of the poster (for poster presentations). All poster presentations should include funding and other acknowledgements where applicable.
7. You give us permission to film or photograph your oral presentation at the conference, which may be used on the RMS website. If you do not wish us to film or photograph your oral or presentation, please email [debbie@rms.org.uk](mailto:debbie@rms.org.uk) to make a statement to this effect. You give us permission to use photographs that may include your poster presentation in the background. If you do not wish us to photograph your poster presentation, please email [debbie@rms.org.uk](mailto:debbie@rms.org.uk) to make a statement to this effect.
8. Abstracts must be submitted in English before midnight on the day of the abstract submission deadline, via the online submission site. Abstracts received after this deadline may not be accepted. Other forms of submission e.g. by fax, email or post will not be accepted.
9. Abstracts will be reviewed and the final decision will be made by the scientific organisers. When submitting your abstract, you may suggest which format you would prefer, however this decision will be taken by the scientific organiser. Their decision on your presentation format is final.
10. Evaluation of the abstract is done on the standard of the content presented. There is no discrimination with respect to the authors' race, gender, religious belief, sexual orientation, ethnic origin, citizenship or political philosophy.
11. Acceptance of an abstract does not imply provision of travel, accommodation or registration for the conference, nor any other cost associated with preparation or presentation of the abstract, or any cost associated with attendance at the conference.
